

Annual CAFO Meeting

Tundra Lodge February 6thC, Crystal Falls February 7th This is the annual update meeting for WPDES permitted farms and all the consultants that work with them. If your farm is on the verge of WPDES permit size or you are wondering about some of the logistics of post-permit management, you may want to consider attending. WI Corn/Soy Conference February 6th & 7th
