TO: All Dairy Project Exhibitors

Let's get ready for the 2019 Oconto County Youth Fair, August 15-18! As you work with your dairy project this summer, don't forget about the required paperwork for county fair due at check-in. Please note all dairy paperwork has been updated this year, and may require additional time to complete.

If you don't have access to internet or a printer, we will be happy to send you copies in the mail- just let us know! Please fill out these materials and bring them with you to county fair check-in:

- **2019 Dairy Pre-Identification Form**—Please complete this form, and list your three educational points.
- **2019 Dairy Cow Identification Sheet**—Complete by answering all the questions on the pages. Records should be complete through July.
- **2019 Dairy Heifer Identification Sheet**—Complete by answering all the questions on the pages. Records should be complete through July.

To be eligible to sell cheese in the 2019 Sale of Champions you will need to complete three educational points with one specific to dairy, exhibit in your age-specific showmanship class, and complete the appropriate forms/paperwork for the animal you are exhibiting.

If you are showing a registered animal, the animal's registration papers must list the specific youth exhibitor or family as owners.

You will also need to give a count for dairy animals in each of the following categories: cows, yearlings and calves. Any information given after August 1, will not guarantee the appropriate stall dimensions for your animals brought to the fair.
