- Educational Point Requirement Information Sheet- The document explains educational points, who needs them, and how you can earn them. One of these points should be directly related to the Swine Project. (**REMEMBER:** Daily chores or working on a farm no longer counts as an educational point. Please read through the list carefully to make sure you are obtaining appropriate educational points!)
