#### NEW Horse Quiz Bowl Team — One Spot Still Available

New this year, one of our 4-H leader's, Brigid McDowell, is starting a horse quiz bowl team. She is looking for teammates and another leader or two to help her out. If you are interested or have questions please reach out to Brigid at 920-834-9947, this is a land line and doesn't receive text messages.

The 4-H Horse Bowl provides an opportunity for youth in grades 3-13 and enrolled in 4-H horse or horseless projects to demonstrate their knowledge of equine-related subject matter in a competitive setting. These contests provide an educational experience for both participants and spectators.

Youth answer questions in teams of 3 or 4 members and compete against other teams in the same class. Senior class competitors also complete a written exam on their knowledge.

These events consist of quiz-style questions about the following topics: Nutrition and Feed, Health and Diseases, History, Evolution and Breeds, Reproduction and Genetics, Anatomy, and Showmanship Basics.



## WI 4-H Foundation Kicks off Photography Contest

The Wisconsin 4-H Foundation Celebrates the Arts Photography Contest is open to any current Wisconsin 4 -H member, and the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation is awarding cash prizes. The contest will be held virtually, with photos of all entries submitted electronically. Entries are being accepted now through January 31, 2025.

The contest is broken into three categories:

- 1. General Photography
- 2. 4-H Experience Photography
- 3. Clovers on Film

A winner will be chosen in each category with a Best of Show award given to one entry chosen by the judging committee. Category winners will receive a \$50 cash award. The Best of Show entry will receive an additional \$100 cash award. Other photographs may be recognized but will not receive a cash award. To be eligible for the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation Photography Contest, youth must be a 4-H member enrolled in 4H Online for the 2024-2025 4-H Program Year.

Entry Information

- Entries will be accepted from Friday, November 1, 2024, until midnight on Friday, January 31, 2025.

- Each photographer may submit up to one entry in each of the three categories but may submit only one entry in each category.

The winning photos from each category and the Best of Show will become the property of the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation. In addition, any entry may be used by the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation to promote the 4-H program and/or to raise funds for the Wisconsin 4-H program. Proceeds from any Celebrate the Arts event or sales will be split evenly with half invested in the Talen Endowment for 4-H Arts Programming and half used for arts programming in the next 4-H program year.

\*Only one club or individual may do an in-store promotion at any store at one time. Time slots are filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

\*To reserve a date, click on the link below. Fill out the reservation form (all fields are required). \*When you have confirmed your date, the club or individual MUST get Store Manager permission to do the promotion. The Store Manager will provide info about what is allowed, timing, location, etc.

CLAIMING YOUR REWARD: When the promotion is completed, in order to receive your reward, clubs/ individuals must email a photo of the activity (but several photos are appreciated!) within 30 days, and the WI 4-H Foundation will send the gift card to the address provided on the reservation form.
